



*Message Title: Our Hiding Place*

*Text: Isa. 32: 2*

*Date: Sunday, January 20, 2008 at 6:00 pm*

**Introduction:** The “*man*” in our text is the *Man, Christ Jesus*. He is our Hiding Place. He is our Covering from the tempest (shelter from the storm), He is our River in a dry land, and He is our Shadow of a Great Rock in a weary land. He is our Hiding

place! Ps. 91: 1-2 calls Him our Refuge, our Fortress, and our God.

**Tonight**, let’s look at Jesus, our Lord, and our Hiding Place:

1. Everyone needs a Hiding Place from the following things:
  - a. Gal. 6: 7. The displeasure of God. (Heb. 10: 31)
  - b. Titus 1: 15. The accusations of their own conscience.
  - c. Rom. 7: 17-20. The power of sin within.
  - d. I Thes. 2: 18. The power of satan.
  - e. Matt. 10: 28. The wrath of God.
2. Christ in the *Refuge* or Hiding place that everyone needs in their lives. He is a *Refuge* from:
  - a. Jn. 3: 36. He is our Refuge from the displeasure of God.
  - b. Eph. 4: 23. He is our Refuge from the accusations of our own conscience.
  - c. Jn. 8: 36. He is our Refuge from sin within.
  - d. I Jn. 4: 4. He is our Refuge from satan.
  - e. I Thes. 1: 10. He is our Refuge from the wrath of God.
